UNC-CH EMPLOYEE EMERGENCY AND ACCIDENT REPORTING PROCEDURE

In case of an accident or injury in any Department of Chemistry building, all personnel employed by UNC must seek assistance per the ordered list below. For everyone's safety, all incidents must be reported to the Facilities Director, using the Employee's Incident Report form. Accidents requiring medical attention or subject to workman's compensation, must also be reported to Environmental Health and Safety.
